Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 86.13-acre non-standard oil proration unit in the Totah-Gallup Oil Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, NMPM
Section 30: Lot 1, NE/4 NW/4, NW/4 NE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Hagood Well No. 28-G located 765 feet from the North line and 3175 feet from the East line of said Section 30.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 4, of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Totah-Gallup Oil Pool, as set forth in Order R-1882, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard oil proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 86.13 acres.
