Administrative Order NSL-120

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Armenta Gas Unit Well No. 1 to be located 400 feet from the North line and 1190 feet from the West line and in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NW/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as there are no other offset operators, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, as set forth in Order R-565-C, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 3 of Order R-565-C for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.

Administrative Order NSL-116, approved August 13, 1957, for the original proposed location of a well in the NW/4 of the aforesaid Section 27, is hereby cancelled.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an oil well located for your Armenta Gas Well No. 1 to be located 400 feet from the north line and 150 feet from the west line and in the NW 1/4 of Section 27, Township 20 North, Range 10 West, Armenta-Cliff Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.
