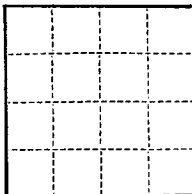

DETAILS OF WORK

To commence at once & drill to 7000'  
To set approx 175' 13 3/8" casing and circulate cement to surface & test for water shut off.  
To set approx 2200' 8 5/8" casing & cement with 200 sacks, test for shut off or leaks.  
To core and DST zones in Hermosa FM between 6000'-6900'.  
To set approx 7000' 5 1/2" casing and cement with 3-400 sacks, to test for leaks and to perforate and complete in conventional manner.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
