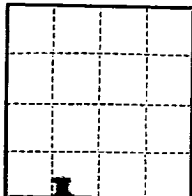

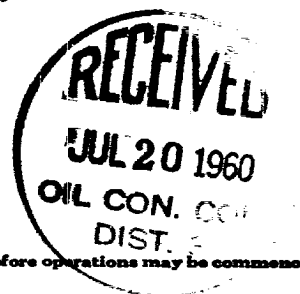

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Total depth 5395'. Ran electric log at 5300' and drilled to 5395'. Set 5-1/2" casing at 5391' with 110 sacks 6 percent cement containing 1-1/2 pounds red plug per sack followed by 100 sacks neat cement. Received good circulation throughout. Tested casing with 3000 psi for 15 minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop. Released rig July 6, 1960.
