Dear Charles:

We have received a copy of the letter you wrote to T.F. Harrigan regarding his #1 Jenkins-Cassady well in Section 19-29N-11W. In this letter you have pointed out that it will be necessary for him to secure approval of his non-standard unit, which is correct. However the letter also indicates that his well is not presently on the proration schedule. Although this well was not on the original schedule as of March 1st, it was granted a supplemental allowable on 3-7-55.

Mr. Harrigan's file is complete so far as this office is concerned. I believe his only problem now is to take care of the non-standard unit. If you have to refer to Brad's notice of connection book the number to refer to is 37 and the number of the supplemental allowable form is number 1, dated March 15, 1955.

I am writing this in the event that you wish to write Mr. Harrigan, correcting the above error.

Gentlemen:

Your attention is directed to the general letter issued January 24, 1955, by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission outlining the procedure to be followed for prorating gas in the San Juan Basin. As pointed out in the letter, certain wells in the San Juan Basin could not be classified as standard gas proration units, and these wells were indicated as non-standard units on the March gas proration schedule for the San Juan Basin. Further, the letter points out that all non-standard gas proration units must have either administrative approval or a hearing by May 1, 1955, in order to remain on the gas proration schedule. In addition it was outlined in said letter that it would be necessary for all of the proper forms to be filed with the District Office at Antec, New Mexico, before a well could receive its allowable.

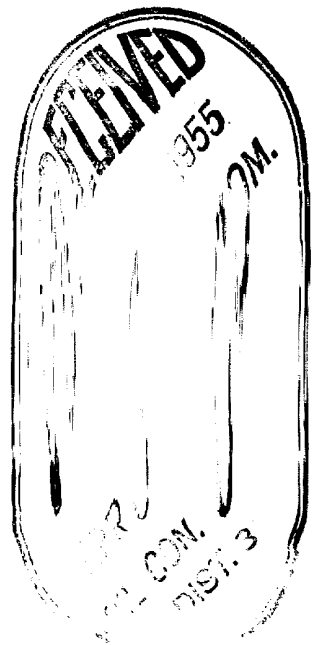

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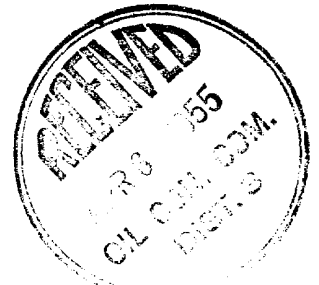
