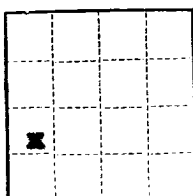

Completed as shut in Gas Well Basin Dakota Field October 26, 1961. Preliminary test October 25, 1961, flowed 3 hours and gauged 7625 MCF per day with tubing pressure flowing 575 psi and casing pressure flowing 1275 psi. Top pay Dakota 6216', elevation ground level 5618'.
