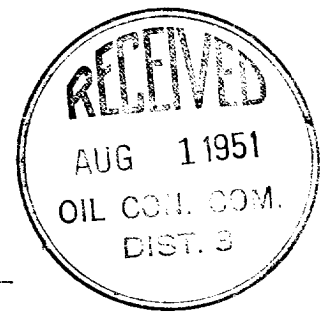

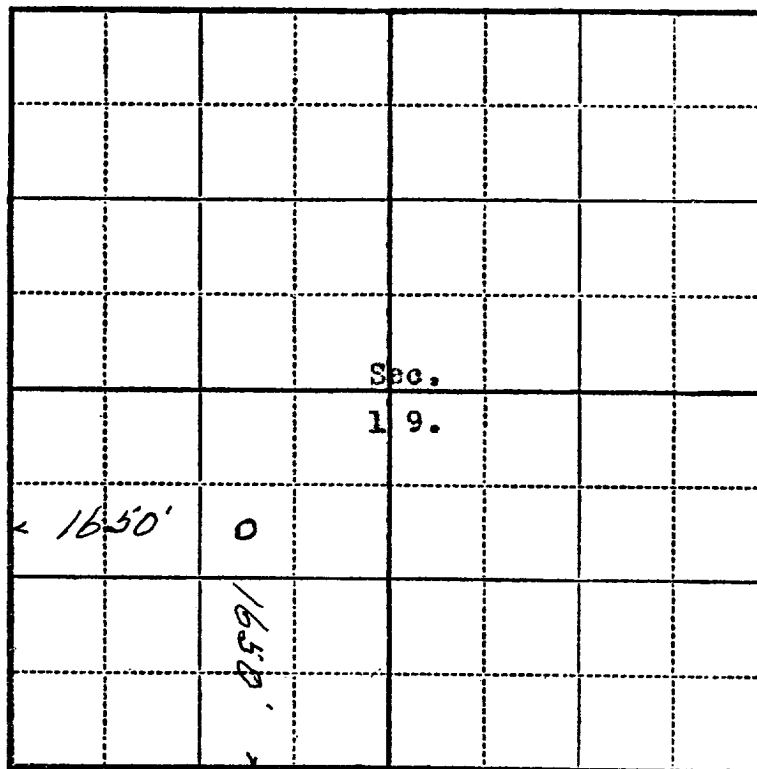
Lease Calleguas Canyon Unit Well No. 1.
