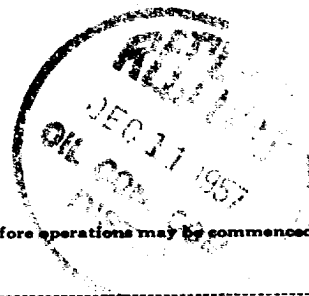

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Cemented 122' of 9 5/8" casing with 125 sacks cement and 2% calcium chloride with 1/4" cello flake on August 19, 1957. Drilled plug and tested with 500# pressure - no leaks - on August 30, 1957.
2. Cemented 206' of 5 1/2" casing with 100 sacks cement and 2% gel on September 1, 1957. 15.50# J-55 Casing
