Dear Mr. Roberts:

I am writing in regard to a well which is being carried on Commission records as the Elvis Roberts #1 Bergin, located in Unit F, Section 21-29N-11W. This well was originally drilled by Mints-Kenaston through the Pictured Cliffs Sandstone and was found dry in this formation and plugged and abandoned in September, 1953. In September, 1959 this well was taken over and plugged back and recompleted at 240' as a small gas well in the Farmington Sandstone; however when the well was approved for production by this office we neglected to require that you file a new acreage dedication plat indicating what acreage had been communitized for the production unit. For a gas well in this formation 160 acres would be required. We are enclosing a supply of Form C-128, Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat. It will be unnecessary for the engineer who originally staked the location to sign the form; however the acreage dedicated should be outlined on the face of the plat and the questions at the top of the page should be answered. The form should be signed by you on the left-hand side as the operator. Please submit three copies of this form to this office.
