DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Spudded 12 1/4" hole on February 5, 1961 and drilled to 213'. Set 8-5/8" casing at 212' with 185 sacks cement containing 2 percent calcium chloride. Circulated 40 sacks cement. After waiting on cement, tested 8-5/8" casing with 400 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Spudded hole to 7-7/8" at 213' and resumed drilling operations.
