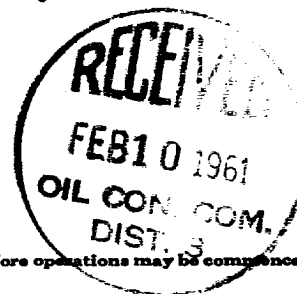

DETAILS OF WORK

Perforated Gallup with 6 shots per foot 4835-4841. Sandoil fracked with 32,500 gallons oil containing 750 pounds admite Mark II and 30,000 pounds sand. Break-down pressure 1500 psi, treating pressure 3000 psi, injection rate 33 barrels per minute. Landed 2-3/8" tubing at 4865'. Completed February 6, 1961 as flowing oil well Cha Cha Gallup field. Potential test February 6, 1961, flowed 237 barrels of oil per day on 18/64" choke.
