in July 18, 1952, 9-5/8" easing was landed at 5320 feet are commended with macks of comment. Flug down at 6150 P. M., July 18, 1952. At 10120 P. M., July 20, 1952, easing and water shat-off were tested at 1000 pounds pump pressure for 30 minutes. So drop in pressure. Sixty feet of solid secont were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1000 pounds for 30 minutes. So drop in pressure. Brilling operations were resumed.
