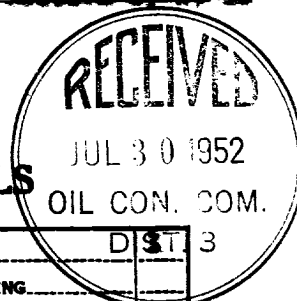

DETAILS OF WORK

On July 18, 1952, 9-5/8" casing was landed at 5328 feet and cemented with 400 sacks of cement. Plug down at 6150 P.M., July 18, 1952. At 10:00 P.M., July 20, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1000 pounds pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Sixty feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1000 pounds for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
