Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

On September 17, 1957, the above well was perforated with two shots per foot 1954-1990, and was then sand oil fracked with 15,000 gallons oil and 22,500 pounds sand, using 110 gallons tretelite in treatment. Frac was preceded with 120 gallons acid. Formation broke at 2350 pounds pressure. Average injection rate 63 barrels per minute. This well was acidized on 10/1/57 with 2500 gallons 10% HCl flushed with 45 barrels oil. Well is at the present time shut in, waiting on orders.
