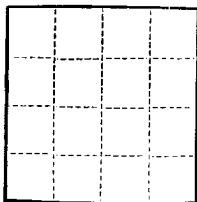

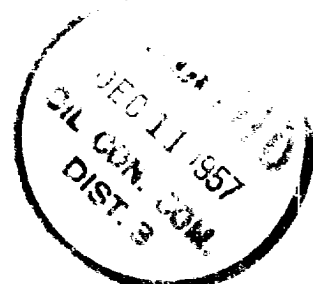

Top of cement by temperature survey at 900'.
