12-21-60: Drilled 7-7/8" hole to 6567'. Set 6564' of 4-1/2", 9.5#, J-55, S3, SRT casing. Cemented 1st stage w/ 200 sks. of 50-50 Diamix, 6% gel, and 100 sks. Reg. Cemented 2nd stage thru D.V. tool @ 2084.48' w/ 200 sks. 50-50 Diamix, 6% gel, and 100 sacks of Reg. WOC 36 hrs. Tested casing w/ 1200# for 30 mins. before and after drilling D.V. tool. Pressure held.
