DETAILS OF WORK

PBD 4677' - Perforated Gallup with 6 shots per foot 4627 - 33. Sandoil fracked with 27,745 gallons oil and 30,000 pounds sand. Frac fluid contained 750 pounds admite Mark II fluid loss additive. Breakdown pressure 1700 psi to 1250 psi. Average treating pressure 2450 psi. Average injection rate 33 barrels per minute. Landed 2-3/8" tubing at 4648'. Completed December 26, 1960 as flowing oil well Cha Cha Gallup Field. Potential test December 26, 1960, flowed 212 BOPD on 20/64" choke, TPF 220, GFF 370, Gravity 43.7° API.
