PROVISIONS OF RULE 104, RESPECTFULLY REQUEST ADMINISTRATIVE EXCEPTION TO OIL WELL LOCATION REQUIREMENTS AND APPROVAL OF NON-STANDARD LOCATION FOR NAVAJO
