DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well with rotary tools to an estimated depth of 6700' to test the Paradox formation. Approximately 300' of 13 3/8" O.D. surface casing will be set and cemented to surface. Approximately 4600' of 9 5/8" O.D. intermediate casing will be set and cemented. A stage collar will be located at approximately 1100' to cement the Dakota formation. A 7" O.D. liner will be set and cemented from approximately 4600' to 6600'. The well will be completed open hole from the bottom of the 7" liner to TD if commercial production is encountered.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

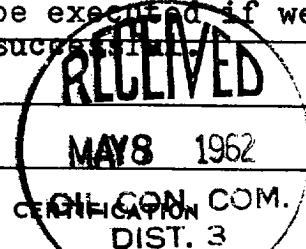

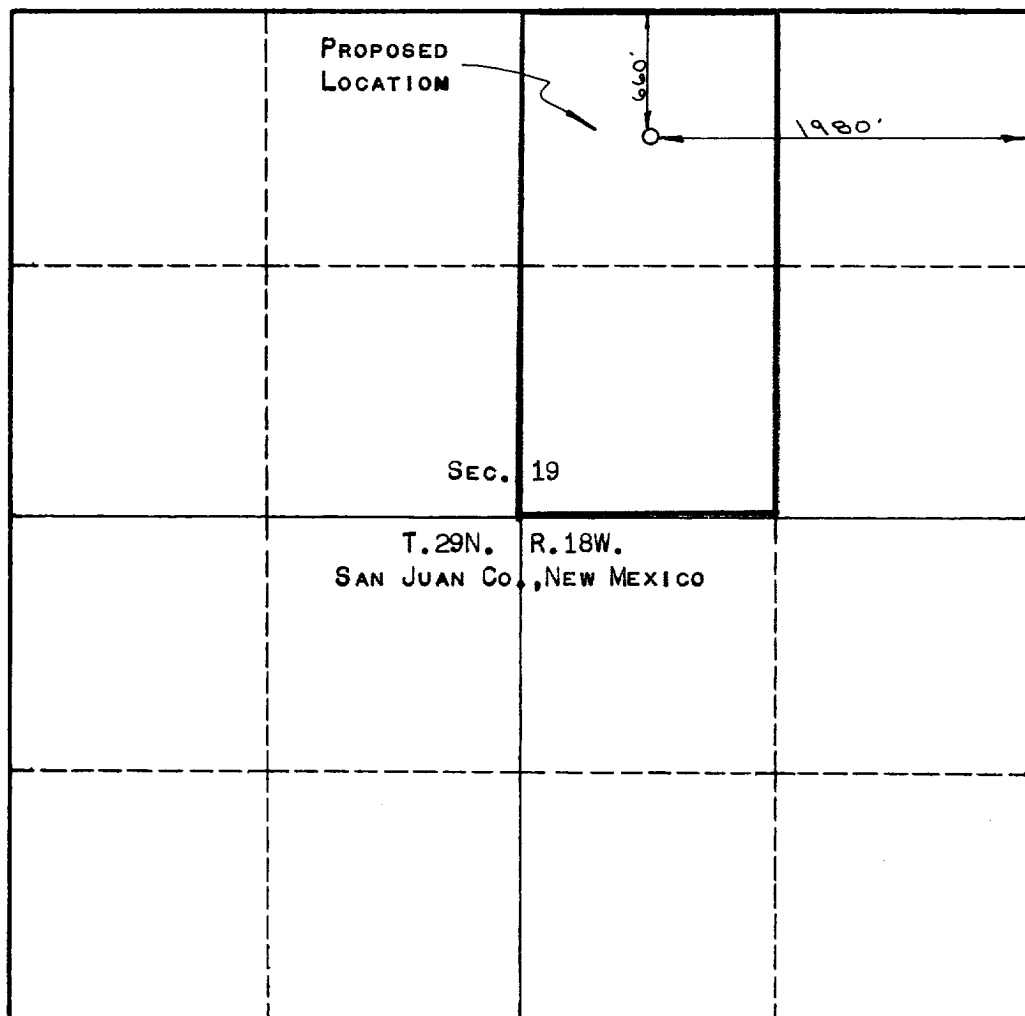

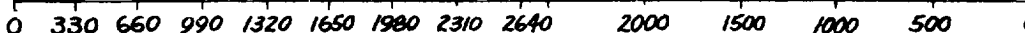
