Dear Sir:

I was in your office Friday April 8, 1960 and talked to Mr. Arroll as you were out of the office at that time, in regards to your letter to Mr. Otto Reynolds dated April 7, 1960. As Otto has been sick and under Doctors care and as I am also interested in this well, I am answering your letter for him.

We have not been producing the well for something like three weeks as we have been waiting for a report from Dowell's laboratory in Tulsa. We sent them cores from the well and they are analyzing them and are to make recommendations to us on a frac job. I have inquired at their office twice and so far they don't have a final report for us.

Our stock tank has not had a fire wall built yet, because we have about a half of a tank of oil in it and we need to empty it before we move it. This oil we intend to use in our fracturing. This has all been hinging on our report from Dowell which we should have any day.

In regards to letter seeking approval for the non-standard location. I wrote a letter dated March 22, 1960 for Mr. John Durr of Burger Drilling Co. He signed it and I mailed it to Mr. Porter in Santa Fe.

Having this letter will satisfactorily explain our actions and wishing to comply with your rules and regulations, I wish to request an extension of two weeks to finish completing this well.
