Spudded 7-7/8" hole on February 19, 1961, and drilled to 80' and reamed to 12-1/4" and drilled 12-1/4" hole to 214'. Set 8-5/8" casing at 219' with 100 sacks cement containing 2 per cent calcium chloride. Circulated 15 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, tested 8-5/8" casing with 550 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 214' and resumed drilling operations.

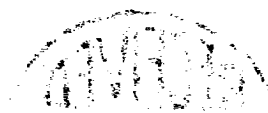
