Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of April 15, 1955, concerning your intention to drill the A. C. Hare Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 of Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

This is to advise you that this office has no objection to the commencement of drilling activities on the aforementioned lease, and operations may be started by you any time after all necessary forms are received at our Atec office.

It is understood that you will continue with diligence to secure a signed lease agreement between Mr. Gilbert Noland and the Basin Natural Gas Corporation. Further, it is understood that all bonus', royalties, etc. which Mr. Noland is entitled to will be set aside for him. Before this unit may be assigned an allowable it will be necessary for Mr. Noland and all other royalty owners in said SE/4 to have agreed to and executed a lease agreement which will permit the communitization of said SE/4. If this has not been accomplished by the time production is obtained it will be necessary for you to request a hearing by the Oil Conservation Commission approving and forcing the communitization in the SE/4 of Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 11 West.
