6. Reason for and duration of exception desired:

Because of the small volume of casinghead gas available and the two miles of gathering line that would be required for a sales connection, a gas tie-in to the Fruitland Navajo No. 1 cannot be economically justified. Practically all of the produced gas is being utilized to supply the gas engine which drives the pumping unit on the well. Exception is requested for an indefinite period or until such time that casinghead gas from the lease is increased.

7. Remarks:

The Jalou Gas Company, which is the nearest gas gathering facility in the area, has presented us a letter stating that the said connection cannot be justified. A copy of the letter has previously been sent to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.
