
Dear Mr. Arnold:

I have been informed that the Basin Natural Gas Company is attempting to unitize the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13-29N-11W as a drilling block.

It is my understanding that the Basin Natural Gas Company holds Oil and Gas Leases on the South half of said quarter-section. I own a new 5-year lease on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section. The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ is Federal land and there is no outstanding lease on the same. I have requested that the Federal Land Office put this 40-acre tract up for bid, at which time I hope to purchase this lease.

In the meantime I wish to contest the granting of any drilling rights as a unitized block on this quarter-section.
