

Thank you for your letter of September 2, 1960, giving us the reported Gas runs from the above Fawkes #1 Well, for January through June 1960.


Will you please send us the figures covering the runs for the above Well for the last half of 1960 (July through December 1960), and also for the months of January and February, 1961.
