APPLICATION

Comes now applicant, Francis L. Harvey, and hereby applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit as an exception to the pool rules of the Aztec Pictured Cliffs gas pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, said rules being Order No. R-565, Rule 6 (a), this application being brought under the provisions of Rule 6 (b) of said order, as revised, proposed unit to consist of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., as reflected by the plat attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, and made a part hereof, the proposed unit containing 155.84 acres, more or less.

In support of the application, applicant would show:

1. That applicant is present owner of all operating rights in the proposed non-standard gas proration unit.

2. That the well producing from the proposed unit, being applicant's Hanley Pool Unit No. 1 well, is located 1650 feet from the South line of Section 18, and 990 feet from the West line of Section 18, and was located and drilled in conformance with the rules and regulations then in effect, and was completed as a commercial well productive of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation.
