Dakota test. West half Section 13 (320 acres) dedicated to this well.

Casing program : Drill 12-1/4" hole to 300 feet and cement 8-5/8" casing to the surface with 200 sacks of 2% CaCl-cement.

Drill 7-7/8" hole to approximately 6,900 feet and cement 4-1/2" 10.5# J-55 casing with 200 sacks 4% gel.

Stage collars will be set below the Pictured Cliffs and Mesa Verde Formations, and they will both be covered with cement if the electric log of the well indicates the presence of commercial sand development.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

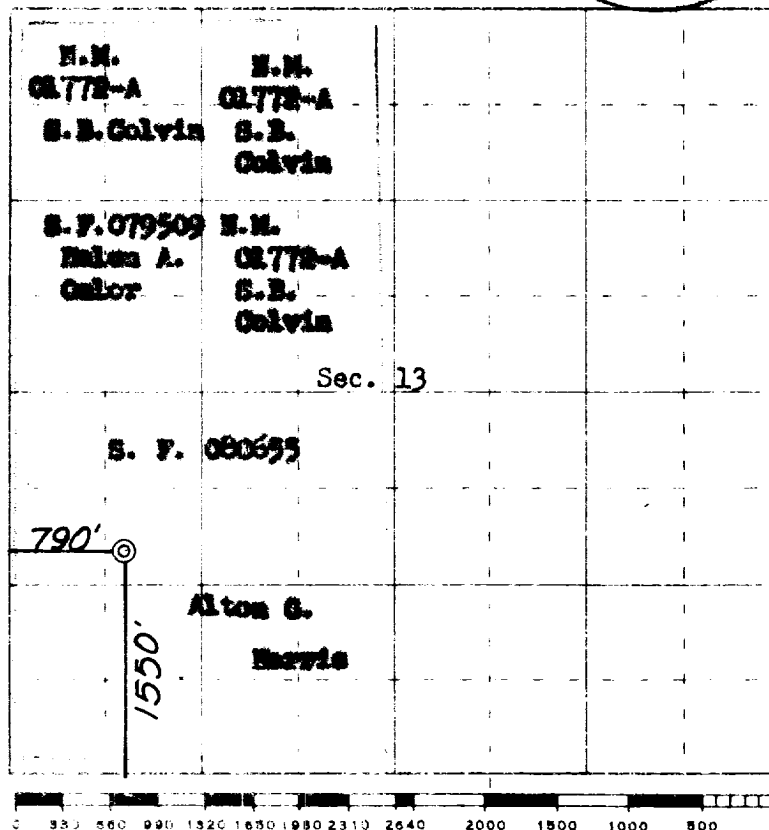
