*We have received two copies of Federal Notice of Intention to Drill for the J. Glenn Turner #1-13 Herrin well located in the SW<sub>4</sub> Section 13-29N-10W. You have stated on the Notice that the Pictured Cliffs and Mesaverde Formations will be cemented through stage collars if the electric log of the well indicates the presence of commercial sand development.*

*It is the Commission's policy to require that formations be covered with cement without exception where such formations are within the horizontal limits of a pool producing from such formation. We are therefore requiring that the Pictured Cliffs and Mesaverde Formations be covered with cement irrespective of electric log interpretations.*
