DETAILS OF WORK

Navajo Tribal "H" No. 8 -- Spudded 7-7/8" hole June 11, 1961. Reamed and drilled 12-1/4" hole to 192'. Set 8-5/8" casing at 190' with 220 sacks cement containing 2 percent calcium chloride. Circulated 15 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement 12 hours tested 8-5/8" casing with 900 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 192' and resumed drilling operations.
