DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED On June 29, 1956, after drilling to 2133' with retary rig (top of Pictured Cliffs 2127') set 60 joints 5-1/2" 0.D. 15.5# casing at 2132 with 100 sacks cement. Moved off.
July 1, 1956. Moved on cable tool. Filled plug. Three hour test kinner showed no water. On July 4, 1956 - after drilling to 2206', loaded 160 quarts solidified mitro-glycerin from 2142' to 2206' - tamped with 5' gravel and 50' calseal. Shot went off at 4:00 A.M. on July 5, 1956.

July 6, 1956 - sand oil treated from 2132 to 2205 with 17,420 gallons diesel oil and 30,000# sand - flushed with 2,580 gallons diesel oil. Breakdown pressure 1300#, treating pressure 1000#, injection 36.3 barrels per minute. July 8, 1956 - cleaned out to 2206' and ran 99 joints (2191') of 1" tubing at 2199'. Shut well in to await potential test and pipe line connections, Robert E. Lee &/or Benson-Montin-Greer Drilling Corp. L. V.
