Pulled rods and tubing 12-17-63. Set retrievable bridge plug at 853'. Perforated First Dakota with 2 shots per foot 788'-792'; 797'-804', and 811'-818'. Sandfraced with 10,000# sand, 11,000 gallons water and 5000 "ADMITE AQUA" additive. Ran 24 joints 2 7/8" tubing with tubing pump, landed at 775'. Ran rods. Pulled tubing 12-22-63. Set retrievable plug at 900', full bore packer at 890'. Squashed water away into Second Dakota - good cement job indicated between First and Second Dakota. Set retrievable plug at 850', packer at 805'. Tested perfs 811'-818' - not sandfraced. Set retrievable plug at 805', packer at 770'. Tested perfs 788'-792' and 797'-804' - OK. Set plug at 828', packer at 808'. Sandfraced perfs 811'-818'. Injected 2500# sand mixed with 2500 gallons water. Communication behind pipe to upper perfs. Cleaned out sand. Ran rods and tubing. Ran RJ submersible pump, set at 760' 12-27-63. Building power lines.

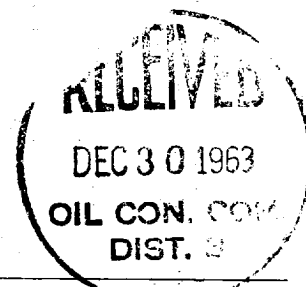

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
