We have received four copies of Form C-110 changing ownership of the #1 Julander Gas Unit well in J-10-29N-11E from Texas Eastern Transmission Company to La Gloria Oil and Gas Company.

Before we will be able to approve this transfer it will be necessary that La Gloria Oil and Gas post a plugging bond with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission as required by our Rules. We are sending you a book of rules and refer you to Rule 101, Paragraph (d) on Page 12. Referring also to the information on Page 11 regarding posting of the bond, you will note that you may either post a one-well bond in the amount of \$5,000 or a blanket bond in the amount of \$10,000. If you anticipate acquiring several wells it might be preferable to post the \$10,000 blanket bond. The completed bond should be mailed to Mr. Ralph Trujillo, Administrative Assistant, Oil Conservation Commission, Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico. Upon receipt of a letter from Mr. Trujillo approving your bond the Forms C-110 will be approved and distributed.
