Harken previously submitted a sundry stating plans to do some additional logging and evaluation prior to year-end. In addition sundries were sent in on the producing wells stating that the Rattlesnake Field was Shut-in during October, in preparation for winter, and would be returned to production in the Spring of 1996. Harken still plans to perform logging and evaluation procedures. However, we respectfully request an extension until the Spring of 1996 when the field will be returned to production due to the fact if the logging proves successful HSW would like to immediately perforate and test. The technical staff believes a better analysis could be obtained if the wellbore could be left on production for an extended period of time. However, due to the amount of fresh water produced in this area, equipment is often incapacitated due to the inclement weather conditions during the winter months.
