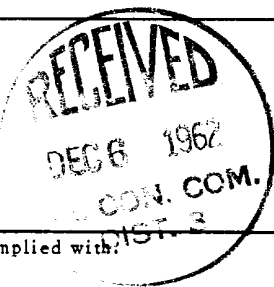

The Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule (C) of the Commission Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators, surface owners, and the New Mexico State Engineer Office have been duly notified; and
3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 (C) will be met.
4. That no objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, Continental Oil Company, is hereby authorized to complete its Federal-Navaajo Well No. 143 located in Unit J of Section 12, Township 29 North, Range 19 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Table Mesa and Rattlesnake formations at approximately 6723 feet to approximately 6880 feet through 2 7/8-inch tubing with a packer set at approximately 6640 feet.
