We will drill 12 $\frac{1}{4}$ " hole and set 200' of surface casing with 100 sx cement, reduce hole size to 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ " to TD of approximately 4800'. Adequate mud will be used at all times. We will drill stem test if any oil show is encountered, and run electrical surveys as indicated. If productive, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " 9.5# casing will be set with adequate cement. If non-productive, we will plug and abandon in accordance with all State and Federal rules. Expected formation tops:

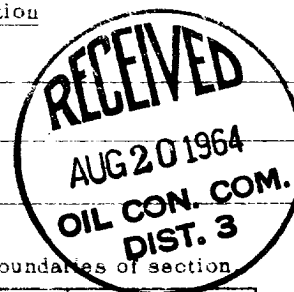
