

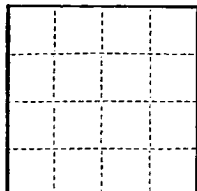

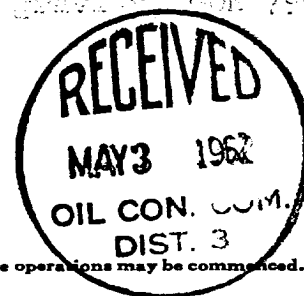

DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled one casing from 6365' to 6436' and drilled out plug, drilled to 6493'. Cased from 6493' to 6830' TB. Ran 2 7/8" tubing, one joint (6530'), and snubbed well in. Released pig 4-23-62. Well completed open-hole from 6436' to 6830' in Pennsylvanian. T.P. 6830'. 3 1/2" BOPD showing on 20/30' choke, 12" drawbar. Con 710. No. 1 pipe collar 12" x 3 1/2" PCPW.
