DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill the above well to 7850 feet or to top of igneous formation unless igneous rock or other impenetrable substance is encountered at a lesser depth. The well will be tested for commercial pay to total depth.

The following casing program is proposed:

19-3/8"	250'	300 SK	20% of calculated amount to circulate.
9-5/8"	2000'	870 SK	17% of calculated amount to fill to surface string.
7"	7250'	480 SK	17% of calculated amount to fill to 2000' above casing shoe.

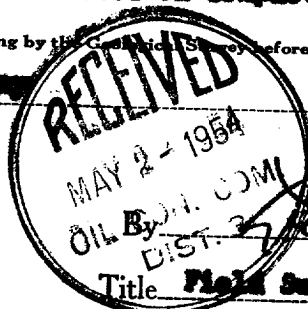
