Displaced with 57 bbls. water - no breakdown. Ran tubing, rods and pump. Completed in the Dakota formation. Pumped 30 bbls. oil and 235 bbls. water in 24 hours 3-8-64. Gravity 65°. COR 1500:1. Crude Oil Purchaser - Four Corners Pipe Line Company. Gas Purchaser - Continental Oil Company for sale to Navajo Tribal Utilities Authority.
