State Gas Unit "T", Well No. 1, was spudded on November 20, 1957, and on November 21, 1957, 8-5/8" casing was landed at 219' with 165 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement for 24 hours, casing and water shut-off were tested with 350 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
