State Gas Unit "T", Well No. 1, on November 25, 1957, 5-1/2" casing was set at 2466' with 510 sacks 6% gel cement, and followed by 25 sacks neat cement. After waiting on cement for 10 days, casing was tested with 2500 pounds (special test) for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
