Reference is made to your application for approval of a 164.38-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Antec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 39 North, Range 10 West
Section 2: NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your State Gas Unit "T" Well No. 1, located 1650 feet from the North line and 1750 feet from the West line of said Section 2.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 6, Section (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Antec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-565-C, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 164.38 acres.
