IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF PAN AMERICAN PETROLEUM CORPORATION FOR AN ORDER PERMITTING THE RECOMPLETION OF STATE GAS COM "BG" WELL NO. 1 IN THE MESAVERDE FORMATION AS AN EXCEPTION TO THE WELL LOCATION PROVISIONS OF THE BLANCO MESAVERDE GAS POOL RULES

## APPLICATION

COMES NOW Pan American Petroleum Corporation and in support of this Application states:

ī.

Applicant, also referred to herein as Pan American, is a Delaware Corporation and is duly authorized to transact business in, and is transacting business in the State of New Mexico.

II.

Pan American is Operator of the State Gas Com "BG" No. 1, a Basin Dakota completion located 1,450' FNL, 1,490' FWL, Section 2, T29N-R10W, San Juan County, New Mexico, an orthodox location for the Basin Dakota Pool.

III.

The Dakota formation is no longer capable of production, and Applicant wishes to abandon the Dakota and recomplete the well in the Mesaverde formation.

IV.

Rule 2 of the Special Rules and Regulations governing the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool as promulgated by Order No. 1670, as amended, requires the location of wells in the northeast or southwest quarter of the section. Completion of the subject well in the Mesaverde formation will require an exception to the above rule since the well is located in the northwest quarter of the section.

Approval of the subject Application will afford Applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

VI.

All other Working Interest Owners in the Mesaverde and Dakota formations underlying the N/2 of Section 2, T29N-R10W, have approved recompletion and support this Application. The location of the proposed well is shown on the attached plat. A log of the well is also attached and made a part of this Application.

WHEREFORE, Pan American respectfully requests that it be granted an exception from Order No. R-1670 to permit recompletion of State Gas Com "BG" to the Mesaverde formation as set out above. Applicant requests this matter be set for hearing, that notice thereof be given as required by law, and that the hearing be held at the earliest convenient time.
