The objective sand is the Pictured Cliffs, expected at about 2450 feet. The casing program is as follows:

175' of 9-5/8" cemented to surface
2450' of 9" O.D. casing cemented with 100 sacks

Well will be drilled with rotary tools to the top of the Pictured Cliffs sand and 9" O.D. casing set. The pay zone will be drilled with rotary tools using natural gas method to a total depth of about 2750 feet.

Well will be shot with about 300 quarts of nitro from 2450 to total depth.

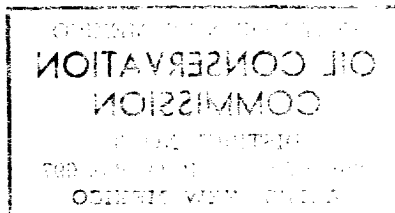

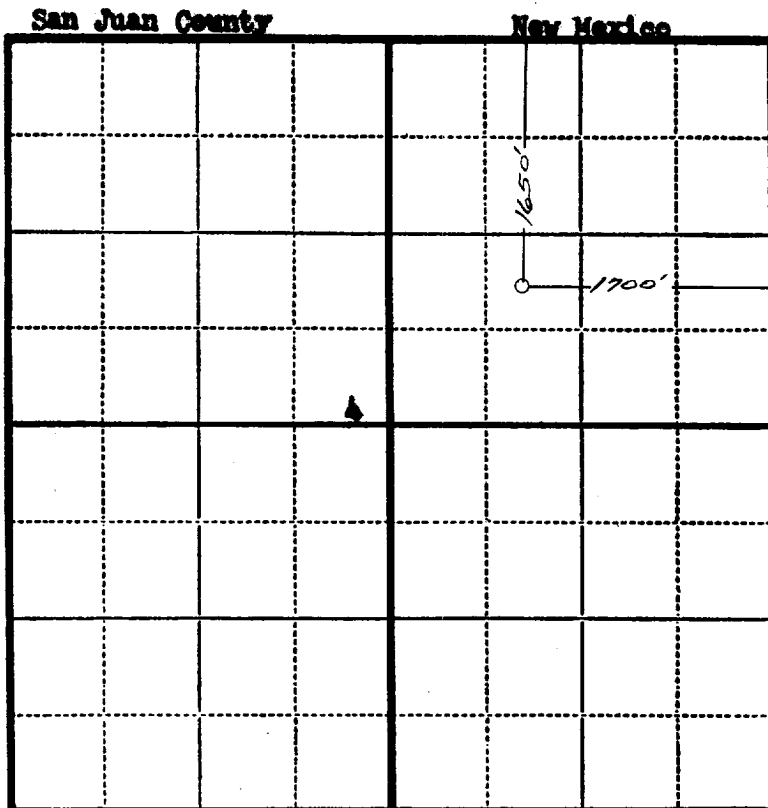
