the Pictured Cliff formation will produce through the casing-tubing annulus.

(Note: It was originally intended to run a siphon string to the Pictured Cliff formation, but no tubing was available. At some future date when tubing becomes available, it is intended to run a siphon line to the Pictured Cliff formation as mentioned in our original notice of enally completing this well.)

- 9. A Garrett, sidedoor flow nipple was installed on the 2" tubing above the production packer. This flow nipple will enable Bottom Hele pressure tests to be taken if they are required at a future date.
- 10. Initial Potential tests have been run and commercial production has been found at both somes. Also a Packer Leakage test has been min and vitnessed by the Astec O.C.C. office. This test shows no communication in the well here between the two producing formations.

Administrative approval is asked for this dual completion to allow production from both known producing formations without the high initial cost of drilling two wells.

The offset operators of this deal completion have been notified and I am enclosing letters from them waiving any objections to it. Also enclosed are:

- (a) Two copies of the Skematic Diagram of the mechanical installations.
- (b) Two copies of the plats showing the location of this well and the offset operators.
- (c) Two copies of an affidavit from the packer setting company stating that the packer used was set at the depth shown.
- (d) Two copies of the packer leakage tests as observed by a number of the 0.C.C.
- (e) Two copies of the initial potential tests showing commercial production from the zones.

It is intended to dedicate the H/2 of Section 5 to the Hesa Verde formation and the HE/4 of Section 5 to the Pictured Cliff production.
