This is to inform you that El Paso Natural Gas Company intends to dual complete our Ludwick #13, located in the NE/4, Section 5, Township 25 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

This well lies within the Aztec Pictured Cliff pool and will be an extension of the Blanco Mesa Verde pool. This dual completion will be accomplished with one tubing string and one siphon string. The Pictured Cliff formation will be produced through the annulus and the Mesa Verde formation will be produced through one tubing string. A packer will be used to separate the producing zones and a side door valve will be installed on the Mesa Verde tubing for bottom hole pressures.

Upon completion of the well and running of Initial Potential and packer leakage tests we will request administrative approval from the Oil Conservation Commission.
