THE APPLICATION OF DEVONIAN GAS AND OIL COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS FEDERAL WELL NO. 1 LOCATED IN THE SE/4 NW/4 SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM AN UNDESIGNATED FRUITLAND FORMATION AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE FULCHER KUTZ-PICTURED CLIFFS POOL.

ORDER NO. DC-812

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Devonian Gas and Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on August 24, 1959 for permission to dually complete its Federal Well No. 1 located in the SE/4 NW/4 Section 4, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Fruitland Formation and the production of gas from the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of September, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'e' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Devonian Gas and Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Federal Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 NW/4 Section 4, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Fruitland Formation and the production of gas from the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool.
