Attached are copies of the Notice of Intention to Drill filed by Devonian Gas and Oil Company on the subject well, along with Form C-128, Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat. I am also sending Form C-104, Request for Allowable, and copies of correspondence between this office and the Devonian Gas and Oil Company regarding the above unit.

You will note that Devonian Gas & Oil has shown on Form C-128 that they own the lease on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Four. This, however, is not consistent with the letter written this office by Mr. J.B. Hurley, President of Devonian Gas and Oil Company on June 3, 1959. If your company owns acreage within this quarter-section, then the acreage dedication plat filed by Devonian Gas and Oil Company was in error. Due to the above discrepancies Form C-110, Authorization to Transport Gas, was approved in error by this office under the assumption that Devonian Gas and Oil owned the lease covering the Northwest Quarter of Section 4. If your company will send us some sort of affidavit testifying to the ownership of acreage within the quarter-section we will immediately cancel Form C-110 and notify the pipeline company to stop purchasing gas from this well.

I am sending Devonian Gas and Oil Company a copy of this letter so that they will be advised of this claim.

the above well.


You will note that Denonion Gas and Oil has shown on Form O-104 that they own the
lease on the NW 1/4 of Section Four, T12S, R10E, N20W, is not consistent with the latter
written this office by Mr. L. B. Hurley, Assistant of Denonion Gas and Oil Company
on June 3, 1958. If your company owns acreage within this quarter-section, then the
storage deduction filed by Denonion Gas and Oil Company was in error. Due to
the above discrepancy Form O-104, Authorization to Transfer Gas, was prepared in
error by this office under the assumption that Denonion Gas and Oil owned the lease
covering the Northwest Quarter of Section 4. If your company will send us some sort
of affidavit testifying to the ownership of acreage within the quarter-section we will
immediately cancel Form O-104 and notify the pipeline company to stop withholding
gas from this well.

I am sending Denonion Gas and Oil Company a copy of this letter so that they will be
advised of this action.

We are in receipt of your letter of March 7, together with the enclosures.
We appreciate the prompt attention you have given this matter.

My letter of March 2 to you may be a little misleading. Texas Eastern made an assignment to Devonian Gas and Oil Company of the mineral rights to the Base of the Pictured Cliffs; therefore, Devonian is the owner of the NW/4 of Section 4. From all available information we have been able to obtain, Devonian has not executed and filed a Designation of Unit, and it was our intention to obtain from you the status of the well and the unit contained by it. When Mr. Hurley wrote his letter of June 3, he was in the process of working a farmout agreement with Texas Eastern.
