Berry, their division landman, I understand from his letter that they acknowledge the fact that this acreage was properly assigned to the Devonian Gas and Oil Company and that the only difficulty seems to be that a unitization agreement has not been signed.

As both of your companies seem to be in agreement that the lease is owned by Devonian Gas and Oil Company and due to the fact that you also seem to both be in agreement that the unitization will be signed, I do not believe that it is incumbent upon the Oil Conservation Commission to take any further action at this time. We will continue to assign the well an allowable and presume that the problem of the communitization will be negotiated and resolved between your two companies.
