Dear Sir:

We received your letter of December 27, 1961 requesting release of your plugging bond on a well which was drilled as the Robert H. Long #1 Elgin in the NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 3-29N-11W.

The Well Record form which was filed does indicate that the well was properly plugged; however a report of plugging was not filed on Form C-103. We are, therefore, mailing you a supply of this form along with a copy of the Well Record form in order that you may review the information in the event you no longer have the plugging information. Will you please fill out Form C-103 indicating exactly where cement plugs were set, what was used to fill between the plugs and whether or not the location was levelled. Upon receipt of this form in triplicate we will cancel your plugging bond.
