Dear Sir:

We have received your inquiry regarding your #1 Hutchinson well in the Fulcher-Kutz Pictured Cliffs pool.

All necessary information has been filed in order for your well to be placed on the first proration schedule, which period begins March 1, 1955. It will, however, be necessary for you to secure administrative approval for you well as it is on a non-standard proration unit. Oil Conservation Commission rules specify that a Pictured Cliffs well have 160 acres in the form of a square being a regular quarter-section dedicated as the drilling unit. Your plat indicates that your acreage, although being in a single quarter-section, consists of only 80 acres. Therefore Mr. W. B. Macey, present director of the Commission, will have to give administrative approval for this unit. This will have to be done prior to May 31, 1955. I would suggest that you write Mr. Macey regarding the matter between now and that date.
